

'Train the Trainers' school or centre specific, Rebound Therapy Staff Training Course

This course is designed for large schools and centres that have a regular staff training need. Completion of the course will equip and validate senior members of staff to oversee all future basic Rebound Therapy staff training within their specified school or centre.

The practical part of the course is run 'in-house' at the school or centre where the training will take place.

The course is designed to equip the candidates to train staff within the specified school or centre to lead basic Rebound Therapy sessions within that same specified school or centre.

Candidates must have already successfully completed the standard 'level 2' staff training course as detailed on the 'Rebound Therapy.org website and be experienced in running and leading Rebound Therapy sessions.



The 'Train the Trainers' course will be school (or centre) specific and relate in all aspects to existing curriculum objectives.

The course model will comprise the following:

- a) A two day practical, which will cover the common core areas
- b) A distance learning module which will relate to the particular needs and curriculum objectives of the school
- c) A final assessment day

The course content will include the writing of a policy protocol document for the implementation of Rebound Therapy sessions and staff training within the designated school or centre.

The final certification will be issued to all participants on the satisfactory completion of the course and will be owned by each school and trainer.

The two day practical part of the course is held in the designated school or centre and is only open to staff from that designated school or centre.

There is a minimum requirement of three members of staff on this course, all of whom work for the school or centre where the course will take place.



All tutors are required to attend a one day refresher workshop every three years.
